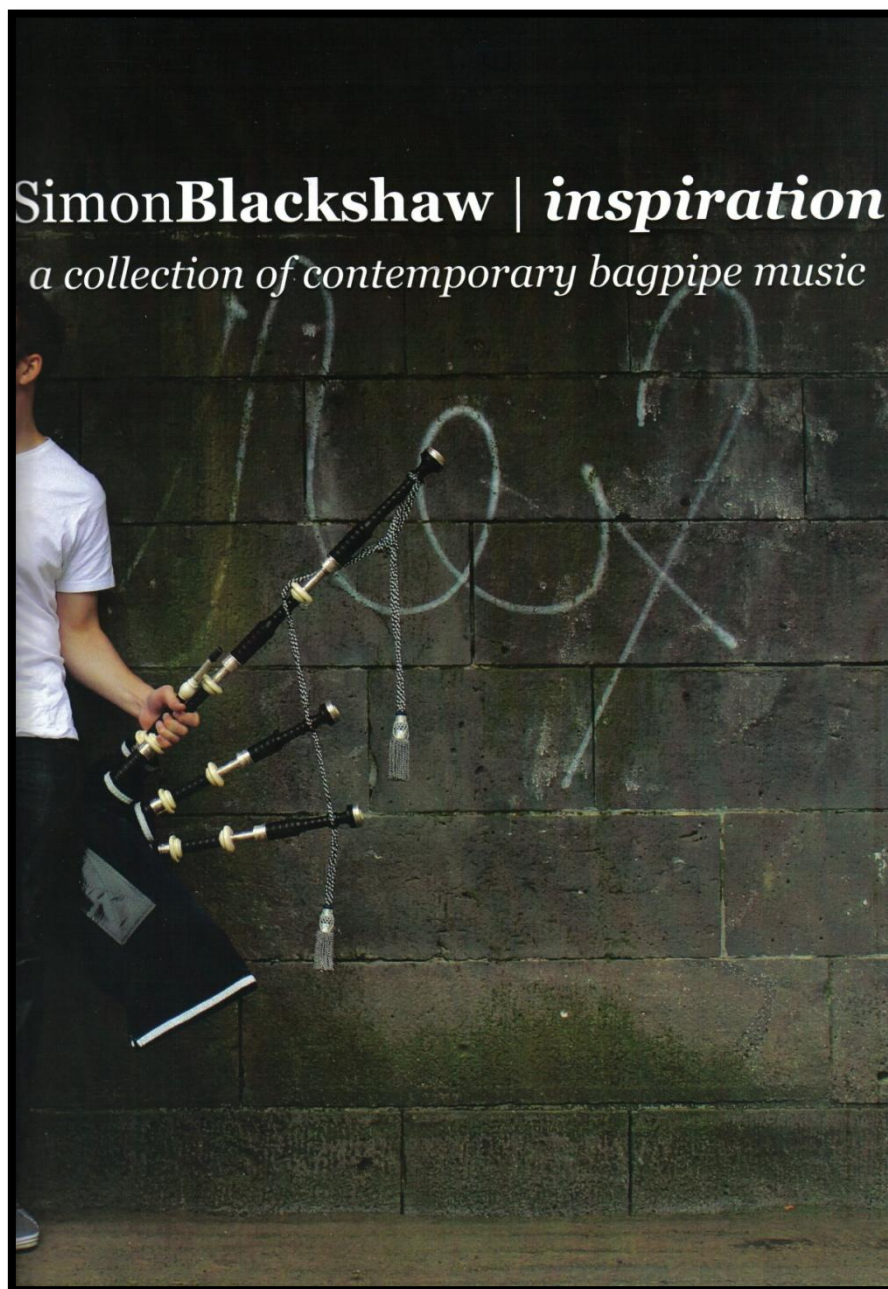


BOOK REVIEW: Inspiration by Simon Blackshaw

Simon Blackshaw is a fine young piper from Melbourne, Australia whose tunes are already featuring in the repertoire of some of the better grade one bands around the world. His first book of tunes "Inspiration" is a well presented publication that contains contemporary tunes for the bagpipe. There are no strathspeys and only 4 march tunes, most of which are far from traditional in style. There are however 3 suites, 10 jigs (including some nice wee 9/8 jigs), 15 hornpipes and 10 Reels, all very modern in flavour with hardly a dotted or cut note to be seen.



Simon acknowledges Mark Saul as one of his sources of inspiration and the style of tune writing has a similarity in its contemporary nature. The book contains the following tunes:
